




Take Your Breath Away - Linwood Barclay





The Baxters - Karen Kingsbury









Love in Plain Sight - Kathleen Fuller





Mulberry Hollow - Denise Hunter





Summer at the Cape - RaeAnne Thayne





What Matters Most - Courtney Walsh




